The HEALTH Research Institute (HRI) leverages an interdisciplinary group of researchers at UH to advance science capable of meeting the health needs of the Houston community and beyond. Our primary mission is to conduct cutting-edge research that transforms basic science, prevention, treatment, and translational strategies that mitigate a broad range of health challenges with the aim of Helping Everyone Achieve a LifeTime of Health (HEALTH).

The HRI is now accepting applications for new Fellows, Mentees, & Affiliates.

HRI Fellows

Fellows of the HRI are faculty who have an NIH Ro1 research grant or equivalent (e.g., ACS, CDC, CPRIT, HRSA, IES, NSF, or SAMHSA grant in excess of \$1M in direct costs) or a sustained record of funding totaling over \$3M as the Principal Investigator (PD/PI or MPI).

HRI Mentees

Mentees of the HRI are faculty who are New Investigators (faculty who have not previously received substantial, independent funding) seeking a supervised career development experience leading to research independence.

HRI Affiliates

Affiliates of the HRI include faculty interested in being included in the Institute's programming and activities.

Membership Application

Fellow and Mentee membership will be based on a competitive application process. Applications for Fellows and Mentees are **due November 1st, 2018**. Applications for affiliates are accepted year round. The evaluation of new membership applications will be based on the applicants' fit with the goals and objectives of the HEALTH Research Institute, research interests, scholarship to date, and future potential as a scholar.

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
